Mr. Shoriak is the director of Major Projects for the Refining Group. His current responsibilities include execution of over \$6 billion of domestic refining projects to be completed between 2009 to 2012, including construction of a parallel refinery in Garyville, Louisiana, increasing crude processing by 185,000 barrels per day (bpd); construction of a heavy oil upgrading project in Detroit, Michigan; MSAT 2 projects to construct benzene extraction facilities for the Louisiana and Illinois refining divisions; and construction of a distillate hydrotreater for the Ohio Refining Division.

Shoriak currently serves as project director for the Garyville Major Expansion Project; manager of projects for the Refining Group; project manager for the Garyville Clean Fuels Projects, the Garyville Coker Projects, and the Garyville Low Sulfur Diesel Projects; and the engineering manager for the Louisiana Refining Division.

Prior to working for Marathon, Shoriak was the engineering manager for a 200,000 bpd refinery in St. Charles Parish, Louisiana; the president of a commercial engineering and construction company in Gonzales, Louisiana; design engineer for an engineering consulting company in Baton Rouge, Louisiana; and design engineer for a major tank fabrication company.

He completed his undergraduate degree in engineering at Old Dominion University, in Norfolk, Virginia, in 1977, prior to earning his master's certificate in project management from George Washington University. He also completed the Marathon Oil Corporation Leadership Program at Indiana University and is a Registered Professional Engineer in the State of Louisiana for Civil Engineering.
